

Introducing KMT's Autocross activity:

A brief overview of Autocross sport:

AutoX on paper appears exceptionally straightforward – utilize activity cones to create a mini-road course in a parking area and see who can get the shortest lap time without hitting any cones or going off course.

Competitors extend from the casual member who may utilize the same car that they drive every day to work to the hard-core driver who encompasses a committed competition car, with competition tires to get the best lap times out of their cars.

Despite the average overall speeds during competition, it's one of the most intense forms of motorsports you can take part in, with basic requirements to participate, that many drivers can be quite competitive at it.

Participation requirements:


- 1- Driver's license.
- 2- Vehicle in good working condition.
- 3- Helmet


How to Participate:

- 1- Check our website for Autocross events to participate in.
- 2- register online before coming to the circuit, racers showing up without online registration will not take part in the event.
- 3- Show up before the event to get a good look at the event's schedule and when to walk the course
- 4- Get your vehicle checked through a tech safety inspection. Also, try to get rid of any loose items inside your car.
- 5- Walk the course. It will surely help you draw your initial racing line that will improve your driving throughout the course.
- 6- Finally, "DRIVE" Have fun! And remember not to hit any cones.

Penalty rules:

- A 2 second penalty is given if:
- 1-Cone is thumped over and is out of the box.
- 2-Cone is thumped over and is within the box.
- 3-Cone remains standing but is out of the box.
 - A penalty is not given if:
- 1-Cone remains standing is touching the box
- 2-Cone remains standing and is partially in the box.
- 3-Cone remains standing within the box.








<u>DNF</u> will be given if the participant passes on the wrong side of the (POINTER CONES) or fails to change sides correctly. (As shown in the drawing below)

Pointer Cone

A DNF occurs in a slalom if the car enters the slalom on the wrong side of a "non-optional" slalom, or fails to alternate sides correctly.



Rules and regulations:

- 1- Everyone must sign the event's waiver to enter the site.
- 2- Restrain your speed heading to the track, burn-outs are prohibited anywhere near the activity. We also demand that you comply with 10 KPH speeds within the stopping and staging areas.
- 3- always wearing a face mask outside your car and keeping a safe distance from one another.
- 4- Failing to obey these simple rules will disqualify the participant from the current event and possibly future events depending on the participant's actions.

Autocross Tips:

This sport is intended to be budget-friendly yet still delivering the highest levels of competition. Therefore, start working on the least expensive upgrade, which is "you," the driver. Once you master the skills of Autocross, you can then upgrade your vehicle.
